Fall Clean-Up September 16-21, 2024 For City of Gilmer Residents

The City of Gilmer will hold fall clean-up on Monday, September 16th and Tuesday, September 17th on the east side of U.S. 271; Wednesday, September 18th and Thursday, September 19, 2024 on the west side of U.S. 271.

Residents are asked to follow the collection schedule and to place leaf bags, brush, or junk items curbside by 7 a.m. each day to ensure pick up. Items must weigh no more than 50 lbs. Brush must be bundled, cut into 3-5 ft. lengths and be no more than 12" in diameter.

Residents will be limited to one (1) truckload of brush or trash per household. Please call City Hall at 903-843-2552 to arrange for pick-up.

Residents may also take multiple loads of brush and trash to the city dumpster site (the old City dump site located at Daylily & Carnation) on Monday, September 16th and Wednesday, September 18th, 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. and Saturday, September 22nd, 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. No permit will be necessary, but a current City of Gilmer water bill will be required to dump.

No tires, liquids, shingles, paint cans, products containing asbestos, air conditioners, electronics, or refrigerators will be picked up or accepted at the old City dump.
